APPRENTICESHIP JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

- Ability to listen and communicate effectively and professionally with all management during normal operating hours.
- Ability to accurately listen and understand verbal questions, instructions, and any questions from peers and management when working onsite and operating equipment in all noise and conditions.
- Ability to work outdoors in all weather conditions, inspecting site conditions, directing and reviewing any corrective actions.
- Ability to walk on uneven ground, or uneven shot rock, sticky mud, and snowy and icy conditions.
- Able to work shift work as required, including night shift.
- Ability to stand and bend for extensive periods of time.
- Often requires crawling, climbing, grasping, kneeling, squatting and twisting.
- Ability to work in heights, climbing and ascending ladders frequently.
- Ability to work productively and meet deadlines in a timely manner.
- Regular and reliable attendance.

SAFETY INCENTIVE COURSES

EACH OF THE FOLLOWING COURSES MEET THE APPROPRIATE SAFETY INCENTIVE COURSES AT THE COMPLETION OF EACH COURSE.

1. OSHA 10 HOUR SAFETY
2. HAZARD COMMUNICATION
3. MSHA APPROVED 24 HOUR
4. HAZARDOUS WASTE WORKER 40
5. FIRST AID/CPR BLOOD BORN PATHOGENS
6. FORKLIFT AND SAFETY
7. SCAFFOLD SAFETY

APPRENTICESHIP INDUSTRY COURSES

APPRENTICES MUST COMPLETE AT LEAST 4 OF THE FOLLOWING COURSES

1. AIR TOOLS
2. ASPHALT REMOVAL & REPLACEMENT
3. CONCRETE REMOVAL & REPLACEMENT
4. LANDSCAPE
5. PIPELAYING
6. BRICKTENDER DUTIES

ENDORSEMENT COURSES (8 HOURS EACH)

APPRENTICES MUST COMPLETE AT LEAST 5 OF THE FOLLOWING:

1. GEN CON
2. FALL PROTECTION
3. AERIAL BOOM LIFT SAFETY
3. SKID STEER I SAFETY
4. SKID STEER II SAFETY
5. AIR TOOLS
6. TRENCH PLATE PROTECTION
7. QUALIFIED RIGGER AND SIGNAL PERSON

ENVIRONMENTAL COURSES

APPRENTICES MUST COMPLETE AT LEAST 1 ENVIRONMENTAL COURSE ELECTIVE

1. ENVIRONMENTAL PASSPORT (40 HOURS)
2. HAZARDOUS WASTE WORKER (80 HOURS)
3. LEAD ABATEMENT WORKER (40 HOURS)
4. ASBESTOS ABATEMENT WORKER (40 HOURS)

REQUIRED COURSE TO QUALIFY FOR PERIOD ADVANCEMENT

1. VOICE ORIENTATION (8 HOURS)

APPRENTICES MUST COMPLETE 144 HOURS OF REQUIRED SUPPLEMENTAL INSTRUCTION (RSI) PER YEAR.

COMPLETION OF THE APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM REQUIRES: 304 RSI HOURS & 4000 OJT HOURS

THE APPRENTICE SHALL MAINTAIN 75 HOURS OF REQUIRED SUPPLEMENTAL INSTRUCTION FOR EVERY PERIOD OF APPRENTICESHIP. MOBILE TRAINING AND SATURDAY CLASSES ARE AVAILABLE.

CHECK THE LOCAL UNION FOR TRAINING SITES AND TIMES.
