

BOARD OF DIRECTORS DRESS CODE POLICY

Effective: March 3, 2023

Unless otherwise stated per conference or event, the nationally adopted SkillsUSA Championships Clothing Classifications, as updated each year, shall apply as the official dress code of SkillsUSA Arizona, with the following modifications.

For Class A: SkillsUSA Attire, the requirement of an "official SkillsUSA red blazer or official SkillsUSA red jacket" is waived. No blazer or jacket is required. If one is worn, it does not have to be an official SkillsUSA item, nor does it have to be red.

For Class C: Competition Specific – Manufacturing/Construction Khaki Attire, the requirement of an "official SkillsUSA khaki short-sleeve work shirt" is modified to "work shirt".

For Class D: Competition Specific – Blue Attire, the requirement of an "official SkillsUSA light blue work shirt" is modified to "work shirt".

For Class E: Competition Specific – Business Casual, the requirement of an "official SkillsUSA white polo shirt" is modified to "polo shirt".

For Class F: Competition Specific – Barbering, Cosmetology, Esthetics, Nail Care, the requirement of an "official SkillsUSA white dress shirt or official white polo" is modified to "dress shirt or polo", and "official SkillsUSA white cosmetology smock or apron" is modified to "smock or apron".

For Class I: Competition Specific – Welding, Welding Fabrication, the requirement of an "official SkillsUSA khaki long-sleeve work shirt" is modified to "work shirt".

In all the above cases, the requirement for the clothing item to be an official SkillsUSA clothing item, or to be of a specific color, has been waived. In all other cases not listed, the same waivers will apply.

No clothing item may include school-identifying branding, text, or other artifacts.

Unless otherwise stated, during conferences and events, on-stage recognition will not be permitted if the individual is not in SkillsUSA official attire (as prescribed by the SkillsUSA Championships Clothing Classifications and modified above), business professional, or business casual.
