MAP OF PHOENIX CONVENTION CENTER

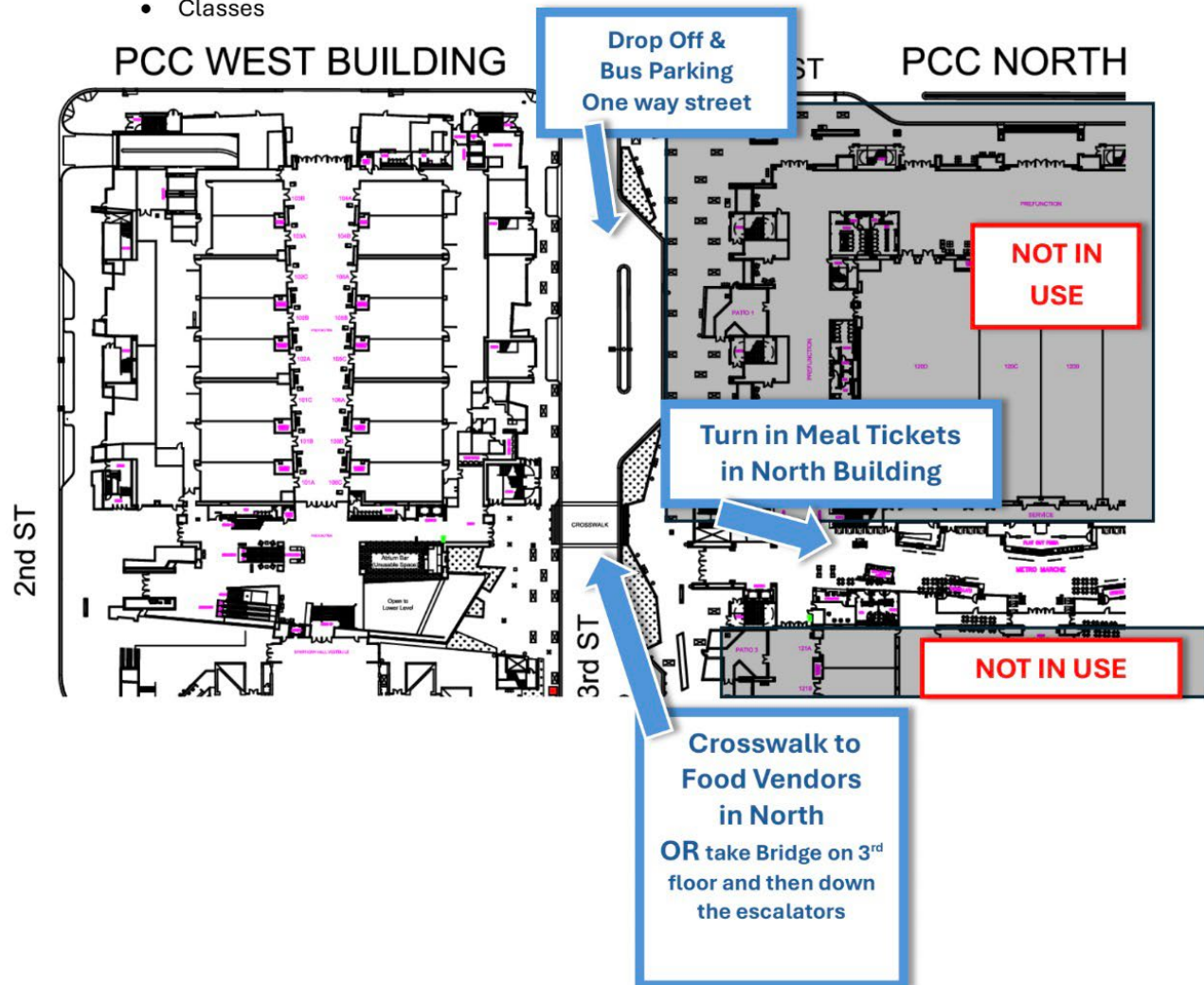

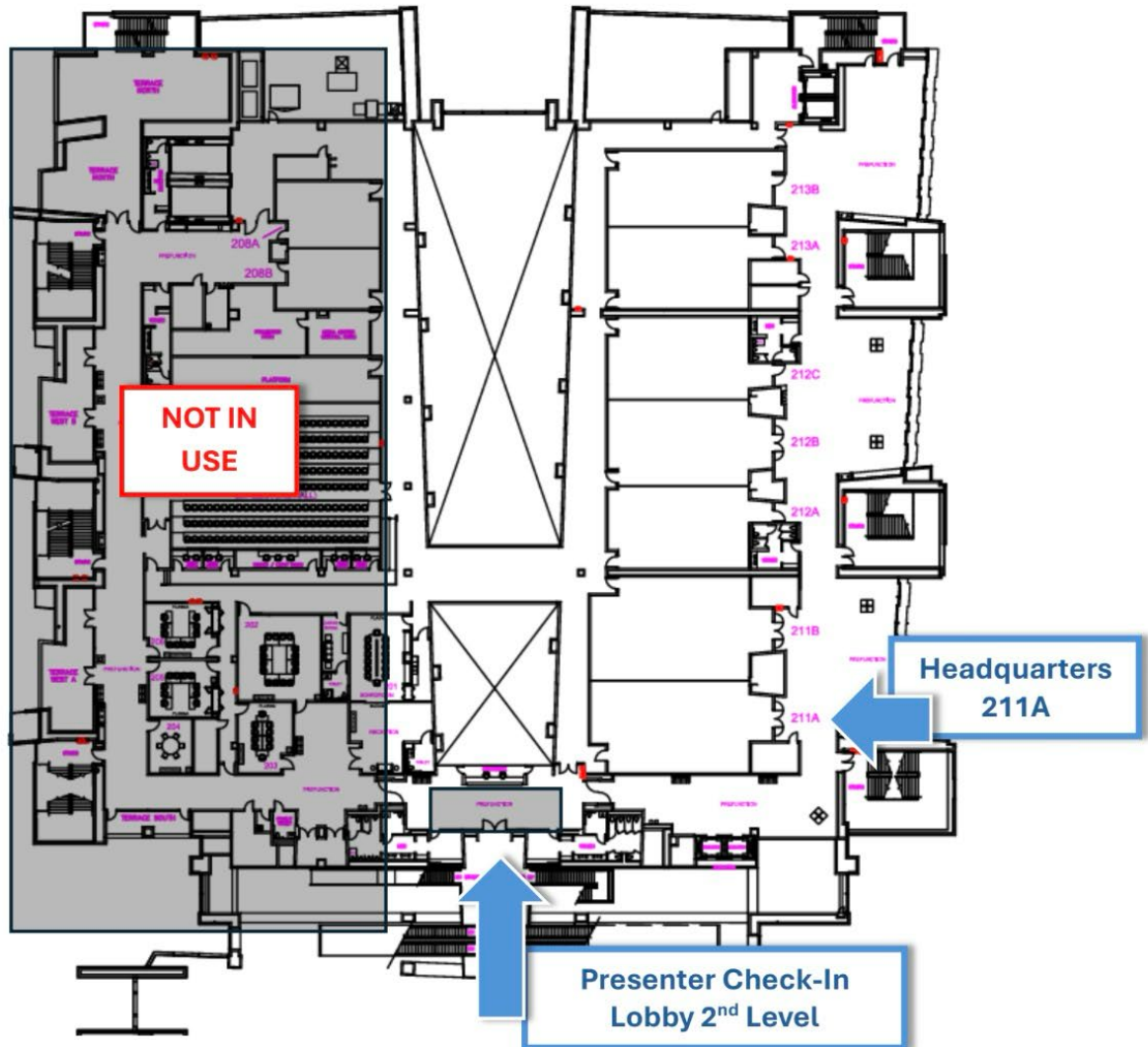

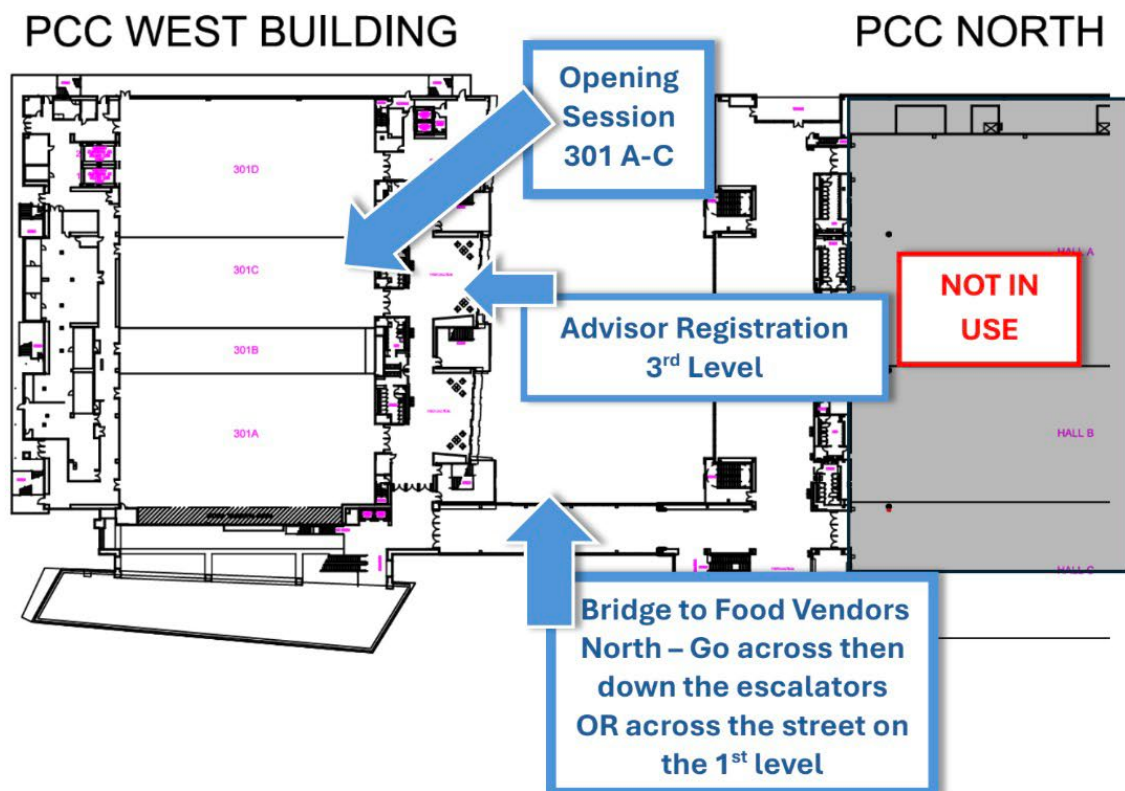
